Update your resume

- A requirement for scholarships, jobs, and/or a letter of recommendation from your counselor (and many teachers, too!)
- Things to include: academic awards/distinctions, leadership activities/roles, athletics, clubs, internships, employment experience, 0 volunteer experience, interests/hobbies/travel, college/career goals, special circumstances, obstacles, etc.

Request Letters of Recommendation (including online recommendation forms)

- Talk to your counselor about any recommendations that you require (even if it's through an online form that requires you to put in 0 your counselors' contact info) - we ALWAYS appreciate a heads up
- Two weeks of notice is appreciated
