- ✓ **Apply for scholarships**
 - Visit the College and Career Center website for a current list of opportunities
 - Review the Millennium Scholarship requirements at https://www.nevadatreasurer.gov/GGMS/GGMS_Home/
 - Important: THERE IS NO APPLICATION – if you qualify, your name will be submitted AFTER graduation
 - Submit the Reed Scholarship application in December – Details to be announced
 - ✓ **Fill out the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid)**
 - Available October 1, 2021, at fafsa.ed.gov (enter web address exactly to avoid scams)
 - No Social Security number? Check if your school(s) offer(s) another type of financial aid (e.g., UNR calls it “Institutional Methodology”)
 - ✓ **Request transcripts from the online records request system**
 - Online at <https://washoeschoolsnv.scriborder.com/>
 - Each student gets 4 FREE requests a year. Beyond that, there is a fee. See website for prices.
 - ✓ **Update your resume**
 - A requirement for scholarships, jobs, and/or a letter of recommendation from your counselor (and many teachers, too!)
 - Things to include: academic awards/distinctions, leadership activities/roles, athletics, clubs, internships, employment experience, volunteer experience, interests/hobbies/travel, college/career goals, special circumstances, obstacles, etc.
 - ✓ **Request Letters of Recommendation (including online recommendation forms)**
 - Talk to your counselor about any recommendations that you require (even if it’s through an online form that requires you to put in your counselors’ contact info) – we ALWAYS appreciate a heads up
 - Two weeks of notice is appreciated
 - ✓ **Reach out for help if you need it**
 - Talk to a parent/guardian/teacher/counselor or other trusted adult
 - Make an anonymous report using SafeVoice – available 24/7/365
